Authors may submit – **in addition to the compulsory short abstract** of max. 1200 ASCII characters - a **one/two page** detailed abstract which may also include figures. This more extensive abstract will be made available to the reviewers and will also be made available on the CD of the Long Abstracts (on an as it is basis) **in addition to** the short form Book of Abstracts. The book of abstracts will not contain the detailed abstracts but will include a special mark with those titles where a detailed abstract is available.

The maximum permitted size of the detailed abstract is two A4 pages or 2.0 MB, whichever is less. The detailed abstract has to be submitted as pdf file, an "author'slastname.pdf" file should be produced. Proofread your abstract after conversion, then upload via the on-line abstract submission system.

To generate the pdf file you may use Acrobat Distiller (<http://www.adobe.com/products/acrdis/main.html>). If this program is not available on your computer, there are several simple to use freewares available for download. Two frequently used sites are adobe (<http://createpdf.adobe.com/>), cute ([www.cutepdf.com](http://www.cutepdf.com)) and pdf995 (<http://site4.pdf995.com/download.html>). Name and source of any software is mentioned without endorsement or taking responsibility for it.

If you are unable to convert your file the submission of doc or rtf files is exceptionally permitted. The content and readability of the submitted file is at the sole responsibility of the authors.

Abstracts must be written in English. The abstract is laid out as follows: title, name(s) of the author(s), their affiliations, keywords, body text and references. Please leave an empty row between the body text and references.

Title should be written with capitals Times New Roman 14. Elsewhere sentence capitalization should be used throughout, i.e. authors, keywords (Sample: "Inclusion complexes, Supramolecular chemistry, Ionic liquids, Thin films") etc.

All abbreviations must be defined before being used as an abbreviation in the text.

References [1] should be restricted to those necessary for the comprehension of the abstract. Reference numbers should be placed at the appropriate point(s) in the text.

Abstracts will not be prepared for publication until the submitting author's Registration Fee has been paid in full. Please note that if the scientific reviewers reject an abstract and the author of the rejected abstract withdraws his registration for the Congress until 15th May, the early bird registration fee will be paid back in full.
